3. Call Multiplier (TSI):
    - a. Used for auto/mass text and voice calls.
    - b. Pay by credit. Each text or voice message is one credit for every number it is sent to.
      - Messages over 160 characters or 30 seconds carry additional costs.
      - Can prepopulate and record messages to be used.
    - c. Can have as many contacts as you want in the system.
    - d. Can be stored in subgroups and message only the groups you need to contact.
    - e. Contacts are uploaded from a spreadsheet.
